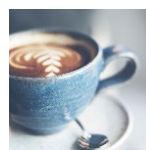

Prayer Topics

- ▶ The Church. Loving God, we pray for all children and young people across our parish and the wider Warrington community. Bless them as they learn, grow and discover who they are. Give them courage when life feels difficult, good friends when they feel alone, and adults who will listen, encourage and guide them. May our church be a place where they feel valued and loved, just as Jesus loves each one of us.
- ▶ The World. Compassionate God, protect civilians in Ukraine and Russia, as well as the Middle East from missiles and fear, and guide their leaders towards peace. Be close to Indonesia as wildfires, choking smoke and the passenger ship disaster bring suffering. Remember communities facing storms and floods in China and Vietnam; shelter the displaced and restore lost livelihoods. Hold those enduring war, hunger and disease in Yemen, Sudan, Myanmar and Congo. Guide governments, health workers and aid agencies to protect the vulnerable, share resources generously and pursue justice.
- ▶ The Community. We pray for those who live and work at Penketh Road, Phillips Drive, Princess Avenue, Pyecroft Close, Pyecroft Road, and Ranworth Road.
- ▶ The Sick. And their families and caregivers
